


To be able to lull yourself to sleep to the sound of waves, you'll need a room with an exterior window, such as an Arctic Superior cabin or one of the suites. These are usually found on the upper decks.

Cabins on the middle and lower decks may be closer to working areas of the ship such as the engine room or the cargo bay, which operate around the clock. If you're a light sleeper sensitive to noise, it's a good idea to pick a cabin or suite from Deck 5 and up.

SUITES

Expedition Suites

Only located on the upper decks, these spacious, sublime rooms are the best The Coastal Express has to offer. Some boast large bay windows or a private balcony with splendid views of the coast.



CABINS

Arctic Superior

Enjoy an outside window with these bigger cabins which are usually situated on the upper or middle decks. Most have views of the passing scenery.

Polar Outside

Found on most decks, this category of cabin comes with a window or small porthole. Some cabins look out onto the midlevel walking deck.

Some Polar Outside cabins are accessible to guests who require adapted bathrooms and other mobility aids. Please note that standard cabins have raised door sills and may not be suitable for larger mobility aids, such as wheelchairs.

Polar Inside


Similar in size to Polar Outside cabins, just without the window. Cabins may have single beds that can be combined into a double, or with one bed converting into a sofa.

The ship is named after the iconic North Cape, the northernmost point on mainland Europe, accessible via the port of Honningsvåg, which we stop at. 





