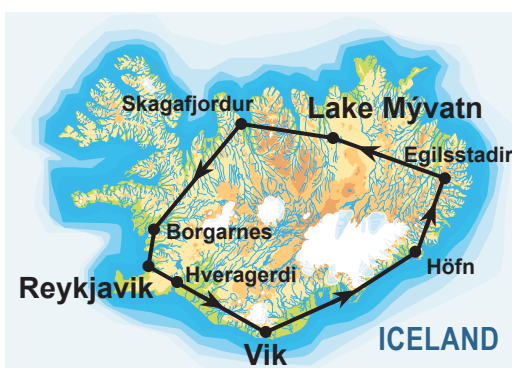

ITINERARY | 10 DAYS



DAY 1 JUNE 11 / JULY 16 / JULY 30

Arrive Reykjavik: Welcome to the Land of Fire and Ice! Independent transfer (no guide) on Flybus shuttle from Keflavik International Airport to Reykjavik. Balance of day free to explore Reykjavik. Meet your guide and travel companions at an information meeting at the hotel. Overnight at Foss Hotel Reykjavik.

DAY 2 JUNE 12 / JULY 17 / JULY 31 [B,D]

Reykjavik—Golden Circle—Hveragerði: Breakfast at your hotel. After a quick introductory of Reykjavik, drive to Thingvellir National Park. Continue to Gullfoss, the “Golden Waterfall,” and the nearby Geysir hot spring area to see the famous Geysir and Strokkur. The day ends in Hveragerði. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Ork.

DAY 3 JUNE 13 / JULY 18 / AUGUST 1 [B,D]

Hveragerði—Vik: Explore enchanting Thjorsardalur valley and its ever-changing landscapes. View a replica of a Viking-age longhouse that was buried by a volcanic eruption of Hekla. Drive along the scenic South Shore. Stop to admire Seljalandsfoss and Skogafoss waterfalls. Continue along Iceland's southern coast with its black sand beaches. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Vik located in Iceland's southernmost town.

DAY 4 JUNE 14 / JULY 19 / AUGUST 2 [B]

Vik—Skaftafell—Höfn: Proceed over the Skeidararsandur sands to Skaftafell, a beautiful glacial area. Visit the stunning Jökulsárlón Glacial Lagoon and Diamond Beach, named for the shrinking icebergs that settle on the black sands before drifting out to sea. Proceed eastward, enjoying magnificent views of mighty Vatnajökull, Europe's largest glacier. Dinner on own in Höfn. Overnight at Hotel Höfn.

DAY 5 JUNE 15 / JULY 20 / AUGUST 3 [B,D]

Höfn—East Fjords—Egilsstaðir: Drive from Höfn through Almannaskard pass, stopping to admire the majestic coastline. Head to the East Fjords with views of towering mountains plunging vertically into the sea. Pass through coastal fjord villages on your way to Egilsstaðir. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Hallormsstadur.

DAY 6 JUNE 16 / JULY 21 / AUGUST 4 [B,D]

Egilsstaðir—Lake Mývatn: Feel the empty vastness of the highland desert plateau en route to the Lake Mývatn area. Stop at Dettifoss, Europe's most powerful waterfall. Explore the natural beauty of the Lake Mývatn area, including the pseudo craters at Skutustadir and peculiar lava formations at Dimmuborgir. Dinner and overnight at Laxa Hotel.

DAY 7 JUNE 17 / JULY 22 / AUGUST 5 [B]

Lake Mývatn—Akureyri: Start the day with a visit to the magnificent Goðafoss waterfall. Afterwards, head to Akureyri, the colorful northern “capital” of Iceland. The town has charming buildings and beautiful view of the Eyjafjörður Fjord. Enjoy a 3-hr boat tour to view whales and other marine life in Eyjafjörður fjord. Dinner on own. Overnight at Berjaya Iceland Hotel Akureyri.

DAY 8 JUNE 18 / JULY 23 / AUGUST 6 [B,D]

Akureyri—Borgarnes: Morning introduction to the unique Icelandic horse breed with its special fifth gait - the tolt. Proceed to Grabrok crater where you can walk to the top for an amazing view. Listen to the powerful rushing waters of Deildartunguhver, Europe's mightiest hot spring area. Dinner and overnight Hotel Hamar in the Borgarfjörður area.

DAY 9 JUNE 19 / JULY 24 / AUGUST 7 [B]

Borgarnes—Reykjavik: Today, explore the amazing variety of natural landscapes in Snaefellsjokull National Park. The park's crown jewel is Snaefellsjokull glacier itself, which covers a dormant volcano that last erupted in 250 AD. See Kirkjufell, one of the most photographed mountains in Iceland. Visit Bjarnarhofn Shark Museum, where you'll learn about “hakarl,” the cured shark meat specialty that Icelanders have enjoyed since Viking time. Proceed to Reykjavik. Dinner on own. Overnight at Foss Hotel Reykjavik.

DAY 10 JUNE 20 / JULY 25 / AUGUST 8 [B]

Reykjavik—Depart: Tour ends following breakfast. Independent transfer (no guide) on Flybus shuttle to the Keflavik Airport for return flight.
