

Mpls/St. Paul—Bergen: Depart on your transatlantic flight. To request alternate dates or for estimated airfare supplements from other US cities, please note on application.

DAY 2 JUNE 6 / JULY 27

Bergen: Arrive at Bergen Flesland Airport. Transfer to hotel. Balance of day free to adjust to time change. Welcome dinner and overnight at the Panorama Hotell & Resort (Tour A) / Scandic Hotel Norge (Tour B).

Bergen: Morning walking tour of Norway's second largest city includes a stroll through the historic Hanseatic Wharf (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Lofthus—Rjukan: Drive to Telemark, an area rich in cultural traditions. Lunch at the Hardangervidda National Park Center. Learn about the thousands of wild reindeer roaming the Hardangervidda plateau through a variety of interactive exhibits. Afterward, proceed to Gaustablikk Høyfjellshotell for dinner and overnight.

Rjukan—Oslo: Visit Vemork, the hydroelectric power plant, where the Nazis produced "heavy water" for their atomic bomb experiments. Learn about the German occupation of Norway during World War II. Lunch on own. En route to Oslo, photostop at Heddal Stave Church, the largest of the remaining 28 stave churches in Norway. Overnight at the Thon Hotel Bristol in Oslo. Dinner on own.

DAY 8 JUNE 12 / AUGUST 2

Oslo: Morning sightseeing tour of Oslo includes a visit to Vigeland Sculpture Park and a photostop at Holmenkollen Ski Jump. Afternoon free for shopping and independent explorations. Farewell dinner and overnight at hotel.

Trondheim: Arrive at Værnes Airport Trondheim. Transfer to hotel in city center. Balance of day free to relax. Dinner and overnight at Radisson BLU Royal Garden.

FRIDAY, JUNE 14 DAY 3

Trondheim: Morning sightseeing tour features the Nidaros Cathedral, one of Scandinavia's most splendid cathedrals. Afternoon free. Dinner on own. Overnight at hotel.

SATURDAY. JUNE 15 [B.D]

Trondheim-Stiklestad-Namsos: Drive to Stiklestad. site of the battle of 1030 which led to the death of King Olav Haraldson (later St. Olav) and the acceptance of Christianity in Norway. Proceed to Namsos, an important trade center. Dinner and overnight at Scandic Rock City.

SUNDAY, JUNE 16

Namsos-Brønnøysund: Enjoy the coastal scenery of Helgeland as we drive north. Norway is one of the world's largest exporters of fish and seafood, an industry employing approximately 21,000. Visit the Norwegian Aquacenter and learn about aquaculture. Continue to Brønnøysund. Overnight at Thon Hotel Brønnøysund.

MONDAY. JUNE 17

[B,D] Brønnøysund-Mo i Rana: Proceed to Mo i Rana, located along the beautiful Helgeland coast in the southern part of Nordland county. Dinner and overnight at Scandic Meyergården.

TUESDAY, JUNE 18 DAY 7

Mo i Rana-Arctic Circle-Bodø: Drive to the Arctic Circle, which marks the boundary of the midnight sun of the Arctic summer and the sunless winters of the north. The Arctic Circle Center provides a visual presentation of the flora, fauna and countryside north of the Arctic Circle. Visit the Blood Road Museum, portraving the plight of prisoners of wars under the German regime from 1942-45. Proceed to Bodø for dinner and overnight at Scandic Havet Hotel.

DAY 8 **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 19**

Bodø-Henningsvær: Depart Bodø for flight to Leknes on the spectacular Lofoten Islands, known for its distinctive scenery. Arrive in Leknes and drive to Borg. Visit the Lofotr Viking Museum, site of the longest Viking Age longhouse. Step back in time as you enter the full-scale replica as Vikings entertain you with stories, song and music. Lunch at the museum. Continue to Henningsvær for dinner and overnight at Henningsvær Bryggehotell.

DAY 9 **THURSDAY, JUNE 20**

Excursion in Lofoten: Sightseeing in the Lofoten Islands includes the Galleri Lofotens Hus in Henningsvær with an exhibition of classical painters from Northern Norway and the Lofoten Aquarium in Kabelvåg. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 10 FRIDAY, JUNE 21

Svolvær-Narvik: Drive to Narvik, established as an icefree port for the iron ore mines in Kiruna, Sweden. A visit to the WWII Museum provides information about that time period in history. A late afternoon excursion by cable car takes us to 2200 feet for an awesome view of the area. Dinner and overnight at Quality Hotel Grand Royal.

DAY 11 SATURDAY, JUNE 22

Narvik-Tromsø: Depart for Gratangen. Tour the North Norway Boat Museum. Visit the Polar Park, the northernmost wildlife park in the world. Proceed to Tromsø, the capital city of Arctic Norway. Dinner and overnight at Radisson BLU Hotel Tromsø.

DAY 12 SUNDAY, JUNE 23

Tromsø: Sightseeing tour of Tromsø includes a visit to the Arctic Cathedral and Polar Museum. Balance of day free. Farewell dinner and overnight at hotel.

Loen-Flåm: Morning excursion to the sparkling Briksdal Glacier. Travel to Skei. Opportunity to purchase quality crafts and woven products at Audhild Viken's Weaving Workshop. Drive to Mannheller. Ferry across the Sognefiord to Fodnes. Drive the world's 2nd longest tunnel (15.2 miles) from Lærdal to Aurland. Continue to Flåm for dinner and overnight at Fretheim Hotel.

JUNE 28 / JULY 17 / AUGUST 18 [B,D] Flåm-Norway in a Nutshell Excursion-Bergen: Board the famous Flam Railway, ranked as one of the top 20 train rides in the world, for a roundtrip ride up and down the Flåm Valley. Cruise the dramatic Aurlandfjord and Nærøyfjord (placed on UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2005) from Flåm to Gudvangen. Meet the motorcoach and drive to Bergen, Norway's second largest city. Dinner. Overnight at the Clarion Hotel Bergen.

DAY 8 JUNE 29 / JULY 18 / AUGUST 19 [B]

Bergen: Morning walking tour of Bergen includes a stroll through the historic Hanseatic Wharf. Balance of afternoon and evening free. Dinner on own. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 9 JUNE 30 / JULY 19 / AUGUST 20

Bergen-Stavanger: Travel the coastal route to Stavanger via Stord. Ferry from Halhjem to Sandvikvåg. Visit the Nordvegen History Centre in Avaldnes, home to the first kings of Norway and the legendary figures who appear so often in sagas and songs. Drive the underwater tunnels from Rennesøy to Randaberg. Continue to Stavanger. Dinner on own. Overnight at the Clarion Hotel Stavanger (Tour A) / Radisson BLU Atlantic (Tours B & C).

DAY 10 JULY 1 / JULY 20 / AUGUST 21

Stavanger: Sightseeing tour of Stavanger. This modern Norwegian city, a hub of the North Sea oil exploration and development operations, is a charming mixture of old and new, retaining much of its 18th century charm. Afternoon free. Farewell dinner and overnight at hotel.


